## MEN'S COACH COMMENTS



### I started coaching Upper Hutt in February 2023 after a two year stint with the Wellington Phoenix Academy.

The first team hadn't been in the Central League for over 12 years, whilst there were many opportunities to get there they unfortunately fell short on the final hurdle.

Looking at the previous programme it was clear that the training in place was not getting the lads fit enough to get to the level we needed to have a chance at a promotion to the Central League.

I had a meeting with them and told them that if they were serious about going up they needed to up the training from twice a week to 3 times in the week. This then became our norm of Monday, Wednesday and Thursday nights. I also added Tuesday and Friday mornings for the ones that really wanted to excel.

The boys didn't love all the running but they got the work done and they didn't complain about it.

It was a roller coaster of a season. We needed to win our last game of the season to get into the playoffs; but if Tawa won they would go through and if both Upper Hutt and Tawa lost, Lower Hutt would have gone through if they won their last game.

Fortunately fate shone kindly on the Hutt and we qualified for the playoffs on the last game of the season winning our final game and Tawa losing.

We beat Palmerston North in both games and as such we achieved our first goal as a team together.

Now we are currently 10 games in the Central League. We knew it was gonna be a big step up but the main priority was to stay up but our goal was to finish mid table. As part of this I had to strengthen the club with a few new signings this season and the squad has definitely up-skilled with all the training.

Our Talent Development Programme is thriving bringing through a lot of home grown talent, the majority of them now training every day wanting to go higher in the game.

Our goal this year as a club was for the Men's 1st team to stay up in the Central League, our Men's Reserves to get promoted to Capital Premier and our 3rd team to get promoted into the Capital 2.

If we achieve this that would be the icing on the cake for a brilliant 2 years in charge with the help of my magnificent staff.

Once that has happened then the next phase is to identify the next best 11 and 12 year olds in the club to prepare them for the Talent Development Programme. Alongside this I am also wanting to help up-skill and grow the Women's programme to try and get our Women's 1st team promoted to the Central League as well.

It's a great time for Upper Hutt City F.C as we take this journey of growth during our Centennial year. Tonight let's appreciate our history and the bright future together.
