

Bob Bamford U19s Tournament - Rules

Match Format

- Group & Playoff Matches: 25 minutes each half, with a 3-minute halftime break.
- Cup Final: 35 minutes each half, with a 5-minute halftime break.
- Playoff Matches: If tied at full time, matches go straight to penalties.
- Cup Final Exception: If tied at full time, 7½ minutes of extra time each way will be played. If still tied, the match proceeds to penalties.

Substitutions

- Each team may make 5 substitutions per game.
- No rolling subs: Once a player is substituted, they cannot return to the field in that game.

Team & Equipment Responsibilities

- The first-named team in the draw is the home team.
- In case of a kit clash, the away team must change to an alternate strip (unless otherwise agreed).
- The home team is responsible for supplying the match ball.

Group Stage Ranking Criteria

Teams will be ranked based on the following:

- 1. Greatest number of points in all group matches
- 2. Greatest goal difference in all group matches
- 3. Greatest number of goals scored in all group matches

If two or more teams are equal on the above criteria:

- 1. Most points in matches between the tied teams
- 2. Best goal difference in those matches
- 3. Most goals scored in those matches
- 4. Drawing of lots by the Tournament Controller

Player Eligibility

- Players must be under 19 years of age as of January 1st of the tournament year.
- Guest players are allowed with approval from their registered club.
- If a complaint is made about an unapproved player, that player cannot participate in further matches.
 - O No penalties apply to games played before the complaint.
 - O Clubs are advised to confirm eligibility before the tournament.
- Players cannot play for more than one club in the tournament without organiser approval.

Clubs Entering Two Teams

- A maximum of 3 players may move from the club's U19 team down to the Development team.
- Any further movement is at the discretion of the Tournament Controller.
- There is no limit on the number of players moving up from Development to the U19 team.

Disciplinary Rules

- Any player receiving two cautions (yellow cards) will be suspended for 1 match.
- A player sent off (red card) is suspended for the next match automatically.
- For serious offences (e.g., violent conduct), the suspension may be increased to two matches.
- Players sent off twice during the tournament will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- A yellow card for dissent will result in a 5-minute temporary dismissal (sin bin).
 - O The team must play with one less player during this period.
 - O This rule applies only to dissent-related yellow cards and is in line with Capital Football regulations.

Note: All cautions and suspensions carry over from Saturday into Sunday.

Coaches, Managers & Officials

All non-playing personnel are subject to Capital Football Playing Regulations and will be held accountable for their conduct.
